

## Justice for 9/11 Victims

e have just observed the 15h anniversary of the terrible national tragedy of September 11, 2001. There is much justice to be done yet. The Justice Against Sponsors of Terrorism Act, or JASTA, has recently passed both houses of the U.S. Congress. This legislation opens the door to pursuing compensation for terror attacks from foreign states who may have funded or otherwise assisted in the attacks.

Once the law is enacted, it will be possible for the first time for families to win compensation from Saudi Arabia. The majority of the 9/11 hijackers were Saudi Arabian; this summer, documents were declassified showing extensive contacts between Saudi officials and the attackers, and likely sources of funding flowing from the Saudi government. In the future, seasoned terrorism lawyers such as those at the Miller Firm should be able to shed much more light on these issues and to make Saudi Arabia account for the terrible toll of the attacks.
